COSTING – ELECTION CARETAKER PERIOD

Name of proposal to be costed:	Clean Energy Agency
Summary of proposal:	The proposal would establish the Energy Savings Agency which will have the following three priorities: to lower electricity bills through negotiating targets and providing incentives to reduce peak energy demands; recommend minimum fair prices that electricity retailers will be compelled to pay to homes and businesses for the electricity they produce; and design a National Energy Efficiency Scheme. The proposal will have effect from 1 July 2014.

Costing overview

This proposal is expected to decrease both the underlying cash balance and fiscal balance by \$1.2 billion over the 2013-14 Budget forward estimates period. This impact reflects an increase in expenses over this period. Given the intended duration of the proposal is five years, this proposal would have an impact in 2017-18 and 2018-19. The impact in 2017-18 and 2018-19 is expected to be equal to that in 2016-17.

The costing includes the departmental costs of the Energy Savings Agency and expenses of the Demand Management Fund administered by the agency.

This costing is considered to be of high reliability as it is based on a capped funding amount specified in the costing request.
